Bath Academy of English is situated in the heart of the City of Bath, in the south-west of England. Located **only 2 hours from London's Heathrow Airport** and 40 minutes from Bristol International Airport, it is very easy to reach by road or train.



BEAUTIFUL - Bath is one of the most beautiful cities in Europe, and is the perfect place to study. Surrounded by rolling green hills, it is full of amazing architecture, with lots of museums, galleries, gardens and other attractions. Bath has been designated a **World Heritage Site by UNESCO**.

English Language Lessons: Monday - Friday 9.00 - 12.15

Bath Academy's well-established Junior Summer School is the perfect environment for teenagers to study English in a **caring, fun atmosphere**. We welcome students from all over the world, and the course is suitable for individual students as well as those coming in groups with leaders.

The Junior Summer School programme is aimed at **12-16 year olds**. For 17 year olds we normally recommend our Adult morning classes combined with the afternoon junior social programme at no extra cost.

Classes have a **maximum of 13 students per class**. All students are tested on their first day to make sure they are placed in the best class for their level.

Lessons consist of 3 hours of General English each morning, Monday to Friday, from 9:00-12:15. At peak periods a split timetable is introduced whereby we run lessons and activities both mornings and afternoons. Emphasis is given on improving students' speaking skills with the opportunity to practise listening, reading, writing, pronunciation work and vocabulary. Lesson topics are linked to the afternoon's activities. There is a mini progress test each week.

All our teachers are **fully qualified English Language teaching professionals** and fully vetted according to British Council and English UK standards.

Students receive a welcome pack, including a **junior-friendly student guide**. All course materials are provided and students are given an exercise book. At the end of the course, each student receives a **certificate** and a personalised report.


