I am staying in a Homestay...

Make sure you have their address and contact information (phone numbers) so you can get there easily.



Contact them when you are on your way from the airport to let them know you will be there soon.



When you arrive at your home your host family will be there to greet you.



When you arrive you will be offered some food and something to drink and can have a rest after your long journey. Make yourself at home!



Your host family should then show you which bus you will need to get to the school the next day.



You should aim to be at school by 9:00am.



Once you arrive you will be registered- please bring your passport and visa if applicable to register.



You are then able to take some tests and meet the Director of Studies.

I am staying in College Residence...

On arrival your warden will be there to greet you, give you your keys and show you around.



You can then settle in and make some new friends 😊



You will be provided with bed linen, towels and essentials. Please ask if you're not sure what you need to bring!



You need to be at school the next day at 9:00am to register. Please bring your passport and visa if applicable.

HOW TO GET TO SCHOOL...

How much will my bus cost me?

To travel around Bath taking the bus is the easiest option 😊



- 1) If you are living in the inner zone your weekly bus ticket will cost you £8.50 if you are under 16 and £17 if you are over 16. If you are over 16 you can also get a student bus ticket for £11.90. For information on how to get this follow the link at the bottom to 'First Group'.
- 2) If you are living in the outer zone your weekly bus ticket will cost you £11.90 if you are under 16, and £23.80 if you are over this age. If you are over 16 you can also get a student bus ticket for £16.70. For information on how to get this follow the link at the bottom to 'First Group'.
